Standard Operating Procedures ("SOP") for Chapel

(updated, with effect from 15th October 2021)

This SOP is subject to changes as may be required to be in line with the Government SOP for Non-Muslim Place of Worship

OPENING HOURS of Chapel:

Monday - Friday 9am - 6pm Saturday 9 am - 12 noon Sunday - CLOSED

Maximum number of persons in the Chapel at any one time: 20

Who May Visit The Chapel

All visitors MUST have the 'MySejahtera' app. It's a COMPULSORY REQUIREMENT to visit the Chapel.

Only persons -

- whose MySejahtera Covid-19 Risk Status is "Low Risk No Symptoms", and
- whose MySejahtera Covid-19 Vaccination Status is "Fully Vaccinated" ** (as defined below), and
- who have not received advisory for Covid-19
 quarantine, have not been notified as close contact to
 Covid-19 person(s), PUI/PUS, and are not staying in or
 been to an EMCO area 14 days prior, and
- for children below 12 yrs old, they must be accompanied by fully vaccinated parent(s).

are allowed to enter the Chapel.

Persons suffering from chronic illnesses, persons who need physical assistance with mobility are discouraged to visit the Chapel.

** "Fully Vaccinated" means for 2-dose vaccines such as Pfizer/ Sinovac/Astra Zeneca, parishioner has received both doses and 14 days have elapsed from date of the second dose, and for single-dose vaccines such as Johnson & Johnson/Cansino, parishioner has received the one dose and 28 days have elapsed from date of vaccination.

Visitor All visitors must first proceed to the registration table in front Registration and of the Parish Office to -Scan before scan the ST SIMON CHAPEL QR CODE with own entering Chapel MySejahtera App, scan BODY TEMPERATURE at the forehead, and submit St Simon GOOGLE FORM registration using the link provided at the registration desk. Show MySejahtera Profile status which must be updated to the day of visit to Chapel, to the Parish office staff. If a visitor's MySejahtera Covid-19 Risk Status is "Low-Risk No Symptons" and Covid-19 Digital Vaccination Certificate confirms to be "fully vaccinated" and having a body temperature below 37.5C, the visitor's "Time In" and "Time Out" are recorded in the chapel registration logbook for his/her time to be in the Chapel. FACE MASK must be worn at all times, upon entering into and until departing from, the church compound. Visitors must sanitize their hands with sanitizer provided at the registration table before entering the chapel. Inside the Once inside, the visitor may take any numbered seat, kneeling Chapel or sitting directly before the seat number and not take any other unoccupied seat. Each person is allowed a maximum of 30 minutes in the Chapel for private prayer. Visitors whilst inside the Chapel must maintain physical distancing of one (1) meter at all times Entry Entering and exiting the Chapel are through the main entrance and Exit door. the Chapel Every visitor must adhere to the "Time Out" as recorded in the chapel registration logbook and end his/her Chapel visit accordingly and leave the church premises directly. Do self-Check-Out of visit on MySejahtera app. DISCLAIMER Should there be an inspection by the enforcement authorities, the visitor shall be personally responsible for summons due to not adhering the SOP as required under Act 342.
