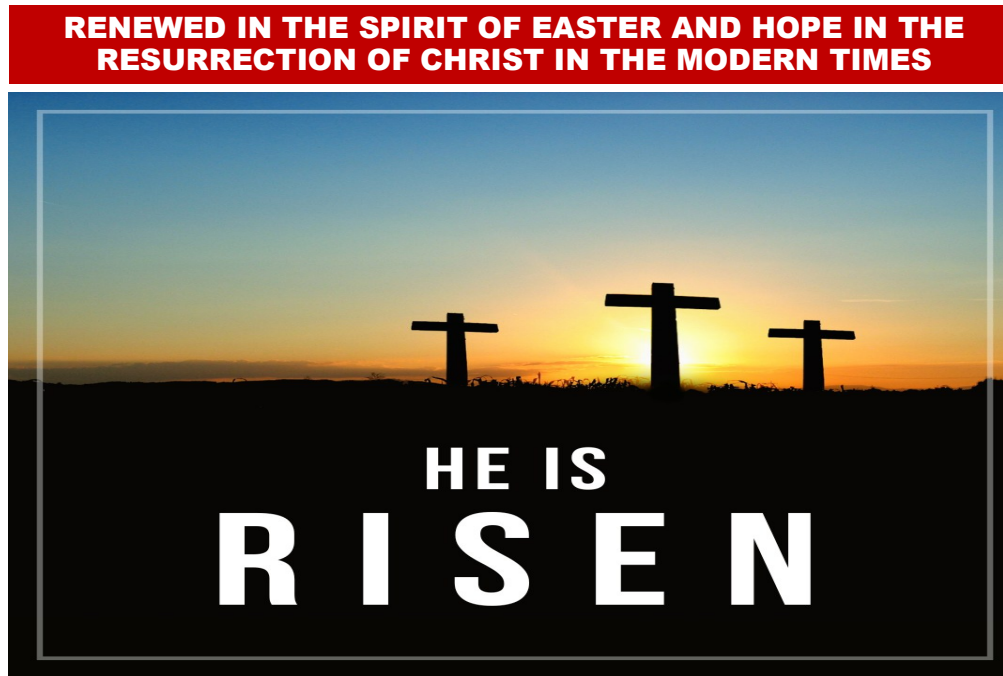

A blessed Easter Sunday to all our brothers and sisters in the Lord. We have ended the season of Lent by reconciling with God through the Sacrament of Reconciliation and entered the Paschal season, marked by the Lord Jesus' resurrection.

Today, as we celebrate Easter, we experience New Life in Jesus Christ. But in the context of modern world nowadays there are so many happenings' around us: the world seems moving rapidly, the transformation of modern technology swelled quickly and lives seems moving beyond expectations. But the love of God remains forever, everlasting and unconditional; "For God so loved the world that He gave His Only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life" (Jn 3:16).

We had seen the many struggles of life, whether in our private life or in public. We had also seen the devastating impact of wars, including the current situation in the Middle East. However, there is still hope for our ever-changing world, that is the great and triumphal resurrection of Jesus Christ our Lord.

The resurrection has always been a source of hope as it reminds us that through Jesus, death is defeated and we are promised eternal life. For



example, St Paul reminds us that through our baptism, we are buried with Christ and we will rise with Christ. Furthermore, the Apostles feared death but remembered Christ's promise of eternal life. That Hope is ignited by witnessing the resurrected Jesus.

Finally, we listen in the Gospels about how Jesus' resurrection becomes our source of Hope for eternal life, with how Mary Magdalen and the Apostles felt after seeing their resurrected Lord. They were happy. They find Peace and harmony. They found the Lord. To the end they found Hope. Therefore, we should become like them. Though we live in fear sometimes in the modern world, we see

Jesus' resurrection as our source of hope and comfort.

Although life brings us many trials but the resurrected Lord is the source of hope. Hence, let us seek Jesus as our source of hope for eternal life through His Resurrection. Think about what St Paul said, "Thinks of what is heaven and not what is on earth. You have died with Christ and your life appears, therefore you will also appear with him in Glory" (Col 3:3-4).
